




June 2012 has seen the completion of 6 living walls at the new eco M&S store in Cheshire Oaks (near Ellesmere Port).

The living walls, which are M&S' largest and most varied walls yet, include 30 types of plants and flowers with many native species reflecting plants found in the local area. Irrigated from a rainwater harvesting system, the wall will provide a habitat for local bio-diversity.

With one living wall wrapping around the entrance to the car park and another green wall around the pedestrian walkway entrance to the car park, the end result is simply stunning!
